Tie-Break Procedures: (if 1st, 2nd & 3rd places are not clearly defined at the end of scheduled frames).

Note: record ultimate ranking next to total # frames won boxes for all entrants at end of proceedings.

- 2 players: Coin toss for break, one frame decider.
- 3 players: Three way play off, 3 frames in total, each player has one break – repeat until 3 are ranked separately.
- 4 players: Four way re-match, one frame & coin toss for break. 6 frames in total.
- 5 players: Five way re-match, one frame & coin toss for break. 10 frames in total.
- 6 players: Random selection of pairs for cut-throat elimination, followed by tie-break scenario for 3 players.
